Come and visit our fun and interactive Indoor Forest and our recently upgraded wildlife display. Under the forest canopy we have 56 species of native taxidermy bird, reptile and mammal taxa. Our **Wildlife Biodiversity Tour** will delight all ages and is a must for those visiting Warburton. In our Day Forest you will find aquatic species such as the Platypus, ground dwellers like the Wombat and Echidna, reptiles and more! Go spotlighting in the Nocturnal Niche to see what lives in our forests at night. Look out for hollow dwelling species such as gliders, possums and owls. And lastly, be careful of the bats and spiders as you exit through the 'Abandoned Mine Shaft'!



The Wildlife Biodiversity Tour offers a unique experience connecting wildlife with their habitats and conservation. These animals are a valuable educational



resource, providing an opportunity for individuals to observe physical characteristics of species that they would otherwise be unable to see while learning about behaviour, distribution, habitats, life cycle/development, threats and endangered species.

The Indoor Forest is an exciting addition to our Eco Tours, either on its own, or complimenting field trips and adding to the forest experience.
